What does WIPA service provide?

Community Work Incentive Coordinators from across the state of Kentucky are available to assist SSI and SSDI disability beneficiaries and their families as well as the professionals assisting them in their return to work with:

- Individualized and personal benefits summary analysis and work incentives planning
- Information about how working will impact their benefits and a look at the bottom line
- Ongoing assistance on issues concerning benefits and work incentives
- Information about transitional assistance, medical benefits, Social Security benefits and work rules, public housing, SNAP, resources for training or education related to employment, as well as information on state and federal benefit programs
- Information on the Ticket to Work program

Choices Navigator

Choices Navigator is a program funded by Social Security under the Work Incentives Planning and Assistance Program (WIPA). It is administered in the western half of Kentucky by the Center for Accessible Living in Louisville.

This program provides FREE work incentives counseling to help SSI and SSDI disability beneficiaries, ages 14 to full retirement age, understand their work options so they can make better, informed choices about going to work.

The Center provides:

- A fully certified and trained Community Work Incentive Coordinator (CWIC), a knowledgeable advocate, who will provide you with an individualized benefits summary and analysis and help you understand and utilize complex work incentive program requirements.
- Information and resources about the availability of Protection and Advocacy services that are available without charge.
