...even those without a regular high school diploma!

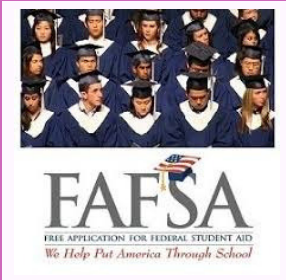
ENROLLMENT

You must enroll at a college or university with a **Comprehensive Transition Program (CTP)**.

A CTP provides a series of audited or for-credit courses with internships or work experiences that lead to a meaningful credential. In Kentucky, there are currently CTP programs at Murray State University and Northern Kentucky University.



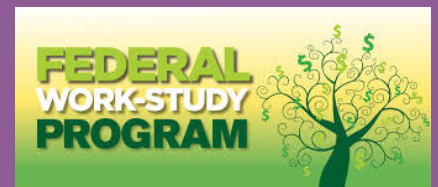
FEDERAL GRANTS



When attending a CTP, you may complete a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** to qualify for a **Federal Pell Grant**.

WORK - STUDY

Completing the FAFSA will also determine if you qualify for the **Federal Work-Study Program**



STATE GRANTS

Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarships (KEES), are available to all students who attend a CTP.

Funds are available for courses taken for credit as well as audited classes. Five hundred dollars (\$500) per semester are available for enrollment in at least six (6) hours of classes, two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) per semester for less than six (6) hours.
